Special Note The JKG Soccer Academy is thrilled to announce that after nine successful summers at the College of Notre Dame, we are **MOVING to a beautiful new location** ideally suited for summer camps – **CAMP DEEP CREEK** in picturesque Western Maryland, near Deep Creek Lake. A charter bus will be provided to transport campers from several local park-and-ride locations to the camp on Sunday and back on Thursday (cost is included in registration fee). The same top-quality standard of care and instruction that people have come to expect from JKG Soccer Academy camps will be maintained, actually enhanced, at the new site. Camp Philosophy The summer camp provides a unique experience for field players and goalkeepers to train separately AND refine their skills against each other. Each day, goalkeepers and field players participate separately in intensive training focusing on finishing and shot handling, practice those skills on each other in integrated training and small-sided games, and test themselves in realistic game situations. In this way, each player is appropriately prepared and challenged to succeed.

Enrollment is open to girls and boys, goalkeepers and field players, from age 5 to 17. Campers are grouped by age and skill level.

Location/Facilities Camp Deep Creek is a “Sports/Reunion/Retreat Complex” located on 18 beautiful acres (some wooded) at Deep Creek Lake in Garrett County (western Maryland). The Camp is surrounded by rolling hills, farm land, horse farms, and views of Wisp ski slopes, one mile from Deep Creek Lake. Due to its location, summer temperatures are very mild, perfect for a soccer camp. Camp facilities include:

- A LODGE that sleeps 24 (individual (bunk)beds) in six bedrooms, with three full bathrooms, and a large living room with stone fireplace, foosball, ping pong, and cable TV/VCR/DVD
- TWO BUNK HOUSES that each sleep 18 (individual (bunk)beds) overlooking the sports pavilion and fire pit, connected by covered deck, carpeted with cable TV
- THREE FIELDS (a regulation soccer field, a softball/baseball field, and a smaller practice field)
- LARGE COVERED SPORTS PAVILLION for inclement weather activities, picnics, evening activities
- OPEN AREAS for other activities (volleyball, badminton, tetherball)

Twenty-four-hour supervision at all sites is provided by camp staff, which includes a professional coach and college counselor for each group. A certified athletic trainer will be on site at all times.

J K G Soccer Academy Residential Summer Camp at Camp Deep Creek

Welcome to the JKG Soccer Academy Summer Camp at the Camp Deep Creek. I hope you are as excited as I am about our June 24th – 28th soccer camp at our beautiful new location in western Maryland for 2007. Please pay close attention to the following information to make your camp experience complete.

Transportation

Transportation will be provided for all residential campers to and from Camp Deep Creek and several park-and-ride locations in Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll/Frederick, and Harford Counties. A charter bus will leave the Baltimore area on Sunday, June 24th in the morning (times and locations to be determined after registration) and arrive at Camp Deep Creek by 4:00pm. On Thursday, June 28th, the bus will depart from camp at 12:00pm to arrive back at the original departure points between 3:00pm – 4:00pm. All costs for the two bus trips are included in the residential registration fees.

Registration/Orientation

Registration for *ALL RESIDENTIAL campers* will be held on **Sunday, June 24, 2007, between 3:00pm and 4:00pm**. There will be signs at the entrance of the facility directing parents and players to Registration. Players arriving by charter bus can check themselves in. Parents and players are welcome to walk around the facilities and grounds.

At registration, you will be required to pay all remaining camp balances. You will also need to provide medical insurance information, if not included on your application form. Residents will receive their room assignments at this time and will move into their rooms before camp begins with a Camp Orientation Meeting at 4:30pm. Dinner and the first evening of games for RESIDENTIAL campers will follow.

Camp Schedule

During the week, RESIDENTIAL campers will go to breakfast at 8:00am. Camp will begin at 9:00am on the soccer field for ALL campers each weekday. Lunch will be provided to ALL campers at 11:30am each day. Dinner will be provided to all RESIDENTIAL campers at 5:00pm Sunday through Wednesday. Matches will be played every evening (Sunday through Wednesday) from 6:30pm to 8:30pm; spectators are welcome. RESIDENTIAL campers will spend the evenings in the Lodge watching DVDs and cable TV, eating snacks from the camp store, and socializing. At Lights-Out each night, all RESIDENTIAL campers will be in their beds in the Lodge or one of the Bunkhouses. There will always be an adult female staff person supervising the girls' accommodations, and an adult male staff person supervising the boys' accommodations. On Thursday, an Awards Ceremony will be held at 11:00am (parents and siblings are encouraged to attend). Checkout for RESIDENTIAL campers will be at 12:00pm.

Meals

Three full meals are included for all RESIDENTIAL campers. All meals will be cafeteria style. Campers can select and eat as much as they want.

Spending Money

RESIDENTIAL campers are invited to deposit their spending money in the Camp Bank. Cash only.

Camp Store

A Snack Bar will be open in the Lodge in the evenings.

Safety & Health Concerns

The JKG Soccer Academy puts the safety of the campers ahead of everything else. Campers are supervised 24-hours per day, for the duration of the camp. Same-gender counselors are assigned to small groups of girls or boys at a ratio of approximately 10:1, and they will always be aware of each camper's whereabouts. Campers are restricted from ever leaving the camp grounds without adult supervision. All activities will be conducted in small groups or camp-wide. An emergency phone number will be provided at Registration. Cell phones will be available at all times. A fully certified Athletic Trainer will be on-site throughout the camp.

The most important advice regarding your health during camp is to pre-hydrate. In other words, start drinking a lot of water the week prior to camp. Bring a water bottle to each session; water will be available. The soccer staff will not be able to administer ANY medications (including over-the-counter medications) without a Medication Dispensing Authorization Form (page 7) completed and signed by a parent/guardian. If you take a regular medication, you can keep it with you or have your counselor keep it. If you think you may need athletic tape, bring it with you. There will be someone available for taping, but you must have your own tape. If you have asthma, be sure to bring your inhaler with you to all sessions and know exactly where to find it when needed. Finally, please make sure that the Camp Director and your Coach are aware of any health problems or special needs.

What To Bring

All campers should bring with them to camp:

- Soccer Ball
- Cleats and Indoor Shoes
- Shinguards
- Soccer Gear (shorts, tees, socks)
- Water bottle
- Athletic Tape, Braces (if needed)
- Sunscreen
- Bug Repellent
- Swimsuit
- Sandals/Flip-Flops
- Rain gear

Goalkeepers should bring, in addition:

- Gloves
- Jersey
- Padded shorts/pants

RESIDENTIAL campers should bring, in addition:

- Bed Linens (sorry, **no sheets/pillow cases will be provided**)
- Pillows
- Towels/Washcloths
- Toiletries
- Alarm Clock
- Electrical Extension Cord
- Favorite DVDs/CDs
- Lanyard
- Window or Floor Fan (**NO air-conditioning**)
